Dear Doctor Apirat,

How are you doing in this year 2009? I hope this mail find you well.

My father is still in a hospital. He had made a lot of progress until September 2008 when he had a severe epilepsys crisis.

He had temporarily lost usage of his right arm, his right leg was not working as well as before and he totally lost all the language he had been able to recover.

Today, he has again physically recovered a lot and can appear as "normal". The ability to speak and read are though very limited and worst than what it was before its September crisis.

Future will tell what he can recover or learn back on that front if anything...

We are currently investigating for his bone reconstruction. All the surgeons that have seen your work have been impressed by the quality of the surgery you performed. One may be able to perform the operation next month but to prepare his surgery, he needs to know more about the technics, tools and materials you have used during your operation.

This doctor from the Foch Hospital in Suresnes is likely to contact you by e-mail to express precisely the information he is looking for.

Without that information, according to the French protocol they would probably have to wait for another couple of years before they can operate...

I hope you will be able to give the expected information.
